Course details:

8. **For questions that the speaker is unable to answer during the presentation, the speaker is required to e-mail written answers to those questions to Dr. Hwang J.-S.** (jshwang@mail.ntou.edu.tw & letmego@mail.ntou.edu.tw) and the student who asks the question
9. Evaluation method for seminar: 70% for seminar report, 30% for course performance, and 6 absences will be considered as failing.
